

TORLYS Floors Stand the Test of Time

TORLYS Smart Floors & Marquee Floors by TORLYS are both a beautiful addition to your home and have been created to ensure that looking after them is easy. The following steps will ensure that your floor looks beautiful for years.

Easy-Care Maintenance Tips

- Clean Regularly Use a clean, untreated dust mop or use a vacuum regularly with a hard surface tool (not a beater bar/rotary brush as they can damage the finish of your flooring). Wipe up spills quickly with a cloth or sponge, and clean as required with a no-rinse, pH-neutral floor cleaner.
 - Refer to our website for current recommendations.
 - Wet mopping is only approved for waterproof floors.
 - Some of our products may be maintained with a residential steam mop on the lowest temperature setting. Refer to our website for current recommendations.
 - Metal / silver embedded mop heads are NOT approved for use.
 - Never wax or use oil-based products on your TORLYS floor.
 - DO NOT use rotating beater bars, floor scrubbers, buffers, spray mops or similar products with TORLYS flooring.
- Only Use TORLYS Approved Maintenance Products Never use highly acidic or alkaline cleaners, non-recommended commercial cleaners or polishes, or a treated mop that has been used to clean other floors or furniture.
- **Protect Your Floors** In entryways and areas of heavy wear, use non-skid mats that are marked "non-staining". Clean mats regularly to avoid build-up. Use protective pads on furniture feet to prevent damage.
 - Furniture pads should have no wrinkles and be made of soft, non-staining material (e.g. felt pads); the felt pads should be of adequate size to support the weight of the furniture and a minimum of 1" (2.5cm) in diameter. The floor protectors should sit flat on the floor and be inspected often for cleanliness and wear. For heavy furniture (e.g. couches) coaster-cups are recommended.
 - Caster chairs require the use of a protective chair mat or soft caster wheels designed for hard surface floors. Check the installation instructions for details.
 - Do not drag furniture or other heavy objects on your floor.
 - Close your curtains or blinds where continuous or extreme sunlight
 will shine on your floor. Also UV protection in windows will help with
 the performance of your furnishings. A combination of heat and
 sunlight can cause most furnishings and flooring to fade or change
 colour.
- Avoid Rubber, latex or fiber-backed mats because they may stain the finish.
- Maintain Humidity We recommend monitoring the relative humidity levels
 (RH) and temperature in your home to minimize expansion and contraction
 of your flooring. Use a humidifier or dehumidifier to achieve the ideal RH
 levels. See specific product warranty documents for required RH range.
- Use Caution When wearing high heels as they can dent TORLYS flooring.
- Check on Your Pets Keep your pet's nails and claws trimmed.
